Concierge

Working in hotels or resorts, Concierges assist guests with bookings, travel advice, and personalised services. While formal qualifications aren't required, experience in hospitality or customer service is essential. Common entry routes include roles such as receptionist or guest services staff, and volunteering in customer-facing positions to help build relevant experience.

Labour Market Fact

Key Information:

- Tuition fees are relatively low compared to European countries and the USA. The opportunity to travel and explore the world's most populous country is another huge draw for foreign students.
- While immersed in the Chinese way of life, you'll have plenty of time to pick up a second language - most likely Mandarin, the country's most commonly spoken language.
- Many employers in China prefer candidates with some experience of the Chinese culture and knowledge of local languages.
- While rankings might be important to foreign students considering where to study, the Chinese place more emphasis on the C9 League, a group of nine universities considered equivalent to the British Russell Group or the American Ivy League.
