Observe GP is an online alternative to work experience for aspiring medics aged 16 and over, who are living in the UK. It is a free interactive video platform providing insights into the role of a GP and the wider primary care team. Watch the introductory video, so you have an idea of what to expect.

BSMS Virtual Work Experience: <u>This course</u> provides online work experience for those considering to apply to medical school. You will be taken through six areas of medicine, exploring the roles, skills required, and challenges faced by today's doctors.

World Spotlight

Country: Cyprus

Key Links: Study in Cyprus | Visa Information

Key Information:

- Bachelors courses, also known as first cycle courses or 'Ptychio', are taught at both public and private institutions, and typically take four years to complete.
- Normally, foreign students from non EU countries are not allowed to work during their study in Cyprus. Exceptions are made by the Government of the Republic of Cyprus for certain courses for which working permits may be issued to enable practical training during the summer vacations.
- For example, UK and overseas students looking to study at UCLan Cyprus can expect to pay €9,950 (£8,625) per year at undergraduate level, although the UCLan Cyprus Bursary can discount this by €950 (£823.50) per year.
- Due to the Bologna Process, university qualifications gained in Cyprus are directly comparable to their UK counterparts.
