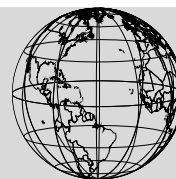

**Key Information:**

- Every province in Turkey has at least one state university, meaning that higher education is widely accessible.
- These 3 institutions feature on the World University Rankings: Middle East Technical University - 269<sup>th</sup>, Istanbul Technical University - 298<sup>th</sup> and Koç University - 323<sup>rd</sup>
- In addition to traditional degrees, short-term certificates and microcredentials are increasingly available making Turkey a flexible option for modular or professional learning paths.
- Turkish universities place a strong emphasis on industry partnerships, startups, and applied research, particularly in Istanbul, Ankara, and Izmir. This provides students with opportunities for internships, projects, and career connections.

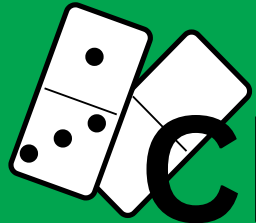

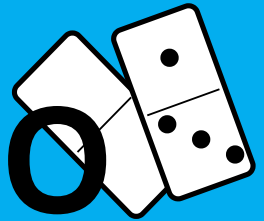
